Rami recently came out as transgender at work. He asked everyone to call him Rami and to use “he” and “him” pronouns from now on. His supervisor and co-workers know, and his co-worker Hana is especially supportive.

Hana notices that sometimes, other co-workers accidentally use Rami’s old name and the wrong pronouns for him. Hana knows they’re not doing it on purpose. But she also knows that using Rami’s old name isn’t supportive.
